Who is eligible to be a student volunteer?

Any full time student may become a student volunteer. However, we especially encourage students to apply who fulfill the following prerequisites:

What do I have to do being a student volunteer?

There will be **two briefings** you must attend. The first briefing will be at the beginning of May, and the second will be at the conference site shortly before the conference starts.
